

Frequently Asked Questions

If you have not played indoor golf or you are not familiar with our facility please review our frequently asked questions.

How long does it take to play a round?

It takes approximately one hour per person playing to complete 18 holes once familiar with the system. Two golfers usually takes about 2 hours, 4 golfers can take 4+ hours. We recommend booking extra time if it is your first time playing. Playing ability will also affect how long it will take you to complete your round. Additional time, if available, can be purchased in 15 minute increments.

What should I bring?

Bring your own clubs. Please make sure your clubs and balls are clean. We have a limited number of clubs for rent. Soft spikes are allowed, but sneakers are actually preferred.

Can I use my own Tees and Balls?

You may use your own tees and balls however, please do not use marked balls as they can leave permanent marks on our screens.

How does pricing work?

All bays are rented by the hour, not by the number of golfers. We don't charge on a per person basis and we don't have an additional fee for multiple players in a group. Rates are based strictly on the number of hours.

When should I arrive?

We ask that you arrive 10-15 minutes early to help keep reservations on time.

Do I need a reservation?

Reservations are *strongly* encouraged, but walk-in are welcome. Our simulators can be in high demand during peak hours and foul weather days.

What happens if I'm late?

If you are more than 15 minutes late, your reservations cannot be guaranteed. If you arrive after your tee time, you will only be allotted the time remaining on your reservation based on availability. Please give us a call if you happen to be running late.
